Since the war began, 5,617 soldiers have been injured, including 833 in serious condition.

"Their underground network is fully operational. We cannot see them with the naked eye, but Beit Hanoun is covered with a massive number of explosive devices and remnants of airstrike bombs.

"Every alley and intersection is filled with the latest cameras... thermal cameras covering 360 degrees.

"They select their targets carefully, monitoring movements via cameras.

"If a drone is detected, they don't activate the explosives, but if military forces approach, they do."
