Nine Israelis were injured while rushing to shelters after a ballistic missile coming from Yemen made impact near Tel Aviv.

Hazam al-Assad, a member of the Ansarallah political bureau, tweeted in Hebrew that "surprises are still coming".

The Israeli Army Radio announced that about 150 rockets were fired from southern Lebanon towards northern Israel during the past 48 hours.

According to Gaza's Ministry of Health, 41,182 Palestinians have been killed, and 95,280 wounded in Israel's ongoing genocide in Gaza starting on October 7.

Monday, September 16, 03:15 am (GMT+2)

AL-JAZEERA: Sirens were sounding in Avivim in the Upper Galilee to warn of rocket launches.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Israeli warplanes launched an air raid on the central Gaza Strip, and the occupation forces bombed the southern areas of Gaza City.

GAZA CIVIL DEFENSE: Six people killed, including two children and a woman, in an Israeli aerial bombardment targeting a house in Gaza City.

Sunday, September 15, 11:00 pm (GMT+2)

AL-AQSA MARTYRS BRIGADES: We targeted "the Zionist enemy vehicles storming Balata camp with highly explosive 'Zofi' bombs, achieving direct hits."

KAN (citing Israeli officials): Israel rejects US proposal to demarcate land borders, considers it a provocation. Israeli officials see the chances of reaching an agreement as low and expect an escalation in the north.

ISRAELI ARMY: Soldiers were slightly injured by shrapnel from two drones that were shot down in the Golan Heights.

KAN: Hamas is preparing for the next phase of fighting in the Gaza Strip, and that the rate of rehabilitation of the organization in the Strip is higher than the rate of dismantling its military capabilities.

FORMER HEAD OF NATIONAL SECURITY COUNCIL: er Benjamin Netanyahu cannot hide the difficult reality, as Israel has fallen into a deepening strategic hole.

Sunday, September 15, 9:30 pm (GMT+2)

KAN: There is a sharp disagreement between Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu and Defense Minister Yoav Galant regarding the escalation in the north.

AL-MAYADEEN: Five martyrs as a result of Israeli shelling of the Zaytoun neighborhood in Gaza City.

GAZA GOVERNMENT MEDIA OFFICE: Among the martyrs are 16,795 children who have been killed since the beginning of the war. The occupation army committed 3584 massacres in the Strip since the beginning of the genocidal war.

AL-MAYADEEN: The Israeli occupation army blows up residential buildings west of Rafah city, south of the Gaza Strip.

Sunday, September 15, 8:00 pm (GMT+2)

AL-AQSA MARTYRS BRIGADES: We bombed a position of enemy soldiers and vehicles in the Netzarim axis with short-range 107 mm missiles.

AL-MAYADEEN: A young man was shot at Bab al-Amoud, a high alert and the gates of the Old City in occupied Jerusalem were closed.

ISRAELI MEDIA: A police officer was injured in a stabbing attack in Jerusalem

GAZA GOVERNMENT MEDIA OFFICE: The number of journalists killed by Israel since the beginning of the war on October 7 has risen to 173.

LEBANESE MEDIA: Israeli warplanes launched a series of Israeli raids on the outskirts of the town of Mahmoudiyah in southern Lebanon.

HEZBOLLAH: We targeted buildings used by enemy soldiers in the Shlomi settlement with appropriate weapons and achieved a direct hit.

ISRAELI MEDIA: Direct hit in "military zone" as a result of fire from Lebanon. Three injuries were reported as a result of a drone launched from Lebanon.

Sunday, September 15, 7:00 pm (GMT+2)

AL-JAZEERA: Sirens sounded in Ghajar and other towns in the Upper Galilee, due to suspicions of infiltration by drones from Lebanon.

ISRAELI INSTITUTE FOR NATIONAL SECURITY STUDIES: The Ansarallah were able to develop their missile capabilities and reach central Israel. This fact increases the potential threat to Israel, which joins the threat of drones.

Sunday, September 15, 6:00 pm (GMT+2)

DEPUTY CHAIRMAN OF ANSARALLAH (to Al-Jazeera): We will not hesitate to target any Israeli enemy site. We develop our weapons in conjunction with studying Israeli defense systems.

ISLAMIC RESISTANCE IN IRAQ: Our fighters targeted a target in occupied Haifa with a drone.

AL-MAYADEEN:

Israeli artillery shelling in the vicinity of Abu Sharia square in Al-Sabra neighborhood, south of Gaza City.

Israeli artillery shelling northwest of Al-Nuseirat camp in central Gaza Strip.

An Israeli air strike targets the west of Rafah city, south of the Gaza Strip.

Sunday, September 15, 5:00 pm (GMT+2)

HAMAS: Recruiting African asylum seekers into the occupation army to fight in the Gaza Strip, in exchange for facilitating their obtaining the right of residence, is confirmation of the depth of the moral crisis that this rogue entity is experiencing.

ABDUL-MALIK AL-HOUTHI: Today's operation was carried out with a new ballistic missile. Our operations will continue as long as the siege and aggression on Gaza continue, and what is coming is worse. We have entered the fifth phase of escalation against the occupation in support of Gaza and its resistance.

AL-JAZEERA: Air raid sirens sounded in the town of Sha'ar Yashuf in the Hula Valley, southeast of Kiryat Shmona, northern Israel.

ISRAELI MEDIA (cited by Al-Jazeera): 2,365,000 Israelis entered shelters due to the missile launched from Yemen at Tel Aviv.

Sunday, September 15, 4:00 pm (GMT+2)

ABU OBEIDA: We commend the qualitative operation carried out by the Yemeni Armed Forces this morning, which targeted a military target near "Tel Aviv." We also highly value the stance of

the dear Yemeni people, standing by their brothers in Palestine and their readiness to make sacrifices for this cause.

HAMAS: Hamas commends the missile strike carried out by the Yemeni Armed Forces and Ansarallah deep in the zionist entity. We consider it a natural response to the entity's aggression against our Palestinian people, as well as against brotherly Yemen and the Arab region.

CHANNEL 12: The army informed the families of three captives, Ron Sherman, Nick Beiser and Elia Toledano, that they were killed in an Israeli attack on Gaza.

KAN: The army opened fire on what it described as a "suspect" at the border area with Lebanon and the incident ended without injuries, without adding further details.

Sunday, September 15, 3:00 pm (GMT+2)

ISLAMIC JIHAD: We praise the missile strike launched by the Ansarallah, which exacerbated "the enemy's crises and revealed its weakness".

ELI COHEN: Israeli Energy Minister Eli Cohen said that the Houthis had already paid a heavy price for targeting Israel previously, adding, "They will also pay the price for launching a missile today".

LEBANESE MEDIA: An Israeli airstrike targeted the vicinity of the town of Rashaya al-Fakhar in southern Lebanon.

PFLP: The Yemeni ballistic response deep inside Israel is a reinforcement of the deterrence equation and a new revelation of the fragility of the Zionist entity.

YEDIOTH AHRONOTH: Israeli authorities called on residents of towns in the Western Galilee to refrain from gathering and to stay near fortified places, for fear of Hezbollah missiles.

WALLA: The Tel Aviv District Court rejected the state's request to cancel a lawsuit filed by some of those who were present at the Nova concert on October 7.

Sunday, September 15, 2:00 pm (GMT+2)

CHANNEL 12: 60 rockets were launched from southern Lebanon towards northern Israel since this morning.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Two Palestinians were killed and others were injured after the occupation targeted the vicinity of Al-Azhar University, west of Gaza City.

Sunday, September 15, 1:00 pm (GMT+2)

ISRAELI ARMY: The Israeli army confirmed that it failed to intercept the missile launched from Yemen, noting that it crashed in the air and its fragments fell near Ben Gurion Airport.

NETANYAHY: "The Houthis must know that they will pay a heavy price for every attempt to harm Israel."

CHANNEL 12: Hundreds of thousands entered shelters due to the Yemeni missile.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Five Palestinians were killed in an Israeli bombardment that targeted Salah al-Din Street in the al-Zaytoun neighborhood in Gaza City.

LEBANESE HEALTH MINISTRY: Four people were injured in an Israeli bombardment on the town of Adaisseh in southern Lebanon, without adding information about their identities.

ISRAELI ARMY RADIO: The leaflet dropping to evacuate a village in southern Lebanon was a private initiative of the 769th Regional Brigade, and was not approved by the army's high command.

Sunday, September 15, 12:00 pm (GMT+2)

LEBANESE NATIONAL NEWS AGENCY: Israeli artillery and phosphorous shelling targets two towns in southern Lebanon.

GAZA HEALTH MINISTRY: 41,206 Palestinians have been killed, and 95,337 wounded in Israel's ongoing genocide in Gaza starting on October 7.

YAHYA SAREE: We carried out a qualitative military operation during which we targeted a military target in Jaffa with a hypersonic missile. This operation comes within the framework of the fifth phase and is the culmination of our efforts to develop missile technology.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Two Palestinians were injured in an Israeli airstrike targeting the coastal Al Mawasi area, which houses displaced people west of Rafah city in the southern Gaza Strip.

Sunday, September 15, 11:00 am (GMT+2)

ISRAELI MEDIA (citing Safed Mayor): Safed is on Hezbollah's radar. The city is dead and we are trying to manage the routine of life in it but that is not possible.

HAARETZ: Haaretz investigation reveals that Israel recruits African asylum seekers in its war on Gaza.

WALLA: Israeli and American spy satellites that were supposed to track potential launch sites in Yemen failed to detect the missile.

ISRAELI ARMY: We are investigating the reason for the delay in detecting the Yemeni missile.

ANSARALLAH: Hazam al-Assad, a member of the Ansarallah political bureau, tweeted in Hebrew: "Surprises are still coming".

AL-MAYADEEN: A number of rockets fell on the Netzarim axis.

YEMENI ARMED FORCES: A statement at 11:30 will announce a qualitative military operation targeting the depth of the Zionist enemy entity in occupied Palestine.

ISRAELI AMBULANCE SERVICE: Nine Israelis were injured while rushing to shelters after a ballistic missile coming from Yemen made impact near Tel Aviv.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Two Palestinians were injured when Israeli boats bombed a tent of displaced people in Nuseirat in the central Gaza Strip.

LEBANESE NATIONAL NEWS AGENCY: The Israeli air force dropped leaflets over the Wazzani area in the south of the country, calling on the residents of the area and its surroundings to evacuate.

CHANNEL 12: Fires broke out in several areas north of the Golan Heights following the launch of rockets from southern Lebanon, adding that firefighting crews are working to extinguish large and expanding fires.

AL-QASSAM BRIGADES: We targeted an Israeli military bulldozer, type "D9", with a "Yassin 105" shell in the Al-Janina neighborhood, east of Rafah, in the southern Gaza Strip, in a complex operation.

ISRAELI ARMY: The Israeli army confirmed that the Yemeni missile traveled about two thousand kilometers to reach Israel, adding that its flight took about 15 minutes to penetrate Israeli airspace from the eastern border.

ISRAELI POLICE: The Yemeni missile fell in the town of Kfar Daniel, in an area near Ben Gurion Airport in Tel Aviv. It caused fires in forested areas and material damage to a main train station near the town of Modiin.

Sunday, September 15, 10:00 am (GMT+2)

ISRAELI MEDIA: The former commander of the Northern Division stressed the need to reach an exchange deal before launching a military operation against Hezbollah, noting his protest against the lack of a strategic discussion regarding what is known as the "day after the war" in Gaza.

ISRAELI LABOR PARTY LEADER: Instead of closing the battle fronts, the zero government is dragging us into war and internal conflict forever.

ISRAELI ARMY RADIO: About 150 rockets were fired from southern Lebanon towards northern Israel during the past 48 hours.

HEZBOLLAH: Hezbollah reported that it targeted Israeli soldiers at the Matla site with a suicide drone, confirming a direct hit. The group also attacked a technical system at the Al-Malikiyah site had been attacked with a suicide drone, confirming its destruction.

ISRAELI MEDIA: The Upper Galilee Regional Council announced the postponement of school hours until 11:00 due to the state of alert and in anticipation of the launch of rockets from southern Lebanon.

ANSARALLAH: The deputy head of the Ansarallah media authority confirmed that the Israeli air defenses failed to intercept the Yemeni missile, stressing that it reached its target.

CHANNEL 13: The army monitored the launch of about 40 rockets from southern Lebanon towards northern Israel in the past hours, noting that some of them were intercepted and others fell in open areas.

Sunday, September 15, 09:00 am (GMT+2)

HEZBOLLAH: We targeted the headquarters of the armored Israeli battalions of the 188th Brigade in the "Rawiyeh" barracks with dozens of Katyusha rockets today.

AL-MAYADEEN (Citing Yemeni sources): Yemeni army carefully studies the defense systems of the enemy army just as it studied the defense systems of the American battleships in the Red Sea.

MAARIV (Israeli newspaper): Former commander of Israel's air defense system as saying that the missile launched from Yemen has a range of 1,700 kilometers and takes 13-15 minutes to reach Tel Aviv from Yemen.
