GAZA LIVE BLOG: Iran Carries Out Major Operation | Deadly Attack in Yaffa | Hezbollah Bombs Tel Aviv – Day 361

The Israeli army said it began its incursions in Lebanon.

Overnight, the Israeli army reportedly carried out eight raids targeting Beirut, in addition to numerous raids and shelling that targeted southern Lebanese towns.

Hezbollah said it carried out strikes at Israeli troops and artillery camps in various northern settlements and that it achieved direct hits.

Meanwhile, Israeli massacres in Gaza continued, as well as stiff Palestinian resistance.

According to the Palestinian Health Ministry in Gaza, 41,615 Palestinians have been killed, and 96,359 wounded in Israel's ongoing genocide in Gaza starting on October 7, 2023.

Wednesday, October 2, 09:45 am (GMT+2)

GAZA MEDICAL SOURCES: 57 people were killed in Israeli raids on different areas in the Gaza Strip since dawn.

HEZBOLLAH: We targeted a concentration of enemy forces and artillery positions south of Kiryat Shmona with a rocket barrage and caused casualties.

TASNIM: Iran had extended flight cancellations until 5 a.m. on Thursday.

ISRAEL'S CHANNEL 12: At least 100 homes in the central Israeli city of Hod Hasharon were damaged by the Iranian attack.

HOME FRONT (ISRAEL): Sirens continued to sound in Kiryat Shmona and towns in the Upper Galilee.

ISRAELI MEDIA: Israeli soldiers were wounded in shelling and exchanges of fire with Hezbollah near the border with Lebanon, adding that the soldiers were taken to Rambam hospitals in Haifa and Ziv in Safed in the Upper Galilee on Wednesday morning.

ISRAEL HAYOM: About 30 rockets had been fired at Metulla since the morning.

HOME FRONT (ISRAEL): Israel's Home Front said sirens sounded in the western and upper Galilee, as well as in several cities and areas in northern Israel.

IRAN (Iranian Parliament Speaker): Iran's next response to any aggression by Israel will be at a very different level.

REUTERS: Danish police say that two explosions occurred in the vicinity of the Israeli embassy in Copenhagen and are being investigated, noting that there are no reports of injuries from the explosions.

HEZBOLLLAH: We targeted Israeli forces in the settlements of Misgav Amam and Shatula with rockets and artillery and achieved direct hits.

AL-JAZEERA: Israel launched raids on the city of Nabatieh and the town of Kafr Kila in southern Lebanon.

HEZBOLLAH: We struck an Israeli military gathering at the Shomera barracks with a rocket barrage and achieved a direct hit.

AL-MAYADEEN:

The Israeli occupation talks about the killing of a soldier in the ambush of Adaissa, but we confirm that the number of dead is much higher.

Israeli helicopters evacuated the dead and wounded soldiers coinciding with the firing of smoke bombs.

The resistance fired at the occupation forces from point zero, which led to the outbreak of large-scale clashes.

The occupation soldiers tried today to enter Al-Adaisseh, but when they reached the barbed wire strip, they fell into a tight ambush.

HEZBOLLAH: Our mujahideen targeted a gathering of Israeli enemy forces and artillery positions south of Kiryat Shmona with a number of rockets and achieved confirmed casualties.

ISRAELI MEDIA: Sirens sound in Shamir in the Upper Galilee.

Wednesday, October 2, 04:00 am (GMT+2)

AL-JAZEERA: The Israeli army targeted the southern suburbs of Beirut with nine raids in about two hours. The airstrikes targeted the areas of Hadath, Ruwais, Choueifat and Haret Hreik.

Wednesday, October 2, 3:40 am (GMT+2)

AL-MAYADEEN:

The Israeli occupation continues its raids on areas in the southern suburbs of Beirut.

Three Israeli raids in Choueifat and Amrousiya in the southern suburbs of Beirut.

A fourth raid targets residential neighborhoods in the southern suburbs of Beirut.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: SIX martyrs and many injuries in the occupation shelling of Al-Amal Institute for Orphans, which shelters displaced people west of Gaza City.

IRAN (The General Staff): The Iranian military attack achieved the required deterrence for Iran, and we hope that the Zionist entity and those who support it understood the message.

IRANIAN MEDIA: Our attacks hit the Mossad base, the Netzarim and Navatim air bases, radars and gathering centers for Zionist tanks.

IRANIAN MEDIA: Military has the capabilities to target the economic facilities of the criminal entity, but we only hit military bases.

IRAN (Chief of Staff of the Armed Forces Major General Mohammad Bagheri): We have gone through a difficult period of restraint since the assassination of Haniyeh in Tehran following repeated requests from the US side and its promises of a ceasefire in Gaza, but the situation is no longer bearable following the martyrdom of Sayyed Nasrallah and Brigadier General Nilfroshan.

IRAN (Army Commander-in-Chief Major General Abdolrahim Mousavi): The United States must receive an important message that if the Israeli entity continues its evil, it will be completely destroyed.

Wednesday, October 2, 12:00 am (GMT+2)

IRANIAN FM: Tehran will respond more strongly if Israel responds.

STANDARD AND POOR'S: Standard & Poor's announced that it has downgraded Israel's long-term credit rating from A+ to A with a negative outlook, due to increased security risks.

ISRAELI ARMY: The Israeli army announced the easing of the Home Front Command's instructions regarding large gatherings in central Israel, after the conclusion of a meeting of the Security Cabinet.

ISRAELI ARMY: The Israeli army asked residents to evacuate a number of buildings in Haret Hreik in the southern suburbs of Beirut.

IRANIAN FM: Our move is over unless the Israeli regime decides to call for further response.

LEBANESE HEALTH MINISTRY: 55 people were killed and 156 others were injured in the Israeli raids that targeted the country yesterday, Tuesday.

Wednesday, October 2, 12:00 am (GMT+2)

AL-MAYADEEN: Nine Palestinians, including a child, were killed in the Israeli aggression that targeted displaced persons west of Al-Nuseirat camp in the central Gaza Strip.

HEZBOLLAH: Targeting the artillery position in "Beit Hillel" with a rocket salvo.

ISRAELI MEDIA: Iranian missile in Beersheba caused damage to the electricity grid.

IRANIAN GENERAL STAFF: If the countries supporting the Zionist entity intervene, we will target their interests and headquarters in the region with force. The Zionist entity should expect the widespread and comprehensive destruction of its infrastructure if it responds to the attack.

KAMALA HARRIS: I will always work to ensure that Israel is able to defend itself against Iran. We will never hesitate to take any necessary action to defend our interests against Iran. Iran is a destabilizing force in the Middle East.

NETANYAHU: Iran made a big mistake tonight and will pay for it.

ISRAELI MEDIA: The death toll in Tel Aviv operation rises to 7.

Tuesday, October 1, 11:30 pm (GMT+2)

ISRAELI ARMY RADIO: The perpetrators of the Tel Aviv operation infiltrated Israel, stabbed a soldier, seized his weapon and carried out the attack with his weapon.

HEZBOLLAH: Hatzarim, Nevatim and Ramon bases out of service after being severely damaged as a result of Iranian missile attack.

CHANNEL 12: 181 ballistic missiles launched from Iran.

AL-MAYADEEN: Artillery shelling and continuous fire from Apache helicopters south of Gaza City.

AL-MAYADEEN: An Israeli drone fires north of Al-Bureij camp in the central Gaza Strip.

PENTAGON: We take the issue of protecting our forces in the region seriously.

PENTAGON: Iran intended to cause damage and destruction in Israel with this attack.

PENTAGON: Iran still has capabilities that enable it to launch additional attacks, and we hope that they will not carry out other attacks.

ANSARALLAH:

We confirm that the operations of the Yemeni army and armed forces are on the rise.

We reaffirm that Yemen will remain active in the battle of support until the aggression on Palestine and Lebanon stops.

Tuesday, October 1, 9:40 pm (GMT+2)

ALI KHAMENEI: "The strikes of the axis of resistance will become stronger and more painful on the decaying and rotting body of the Zionist regime."

TOP HEZBOLLAH OFFICIAL (to Al-Jazeera)

Most of the bases targeted in Israel were hit directly, especially the airbases.

Most of the objectives of the strike were achieved according to the set plan.

Nevatim, Hatzerim, Tel Nof, Netzarim, and Glilot bases were targeted.

The scale of Israeli missile interception was weak.

It has been confirmed that there were significant casualties among Israeli soldiers

ABU OBEIDA:

We congratulate the Iranian response that covered the entire geography of occupied Palestine and dealt a strong blow to the criminal occupation that thought that its rampage in the region and its aggression against its people could pass without punishment.

This is an exceptional day in the history of the struggle, in which the fires of the nation's resistance crossed in the skies of Palestine, and Tel Aviv was exposed to the strikes of the fighters from Yemen, Lebanon, Palestine, and Iran. This is a call to all the free people of the nation to make a share in the liberation of Palestine.

IRANIAN PRESIDENT: The attack was in defense of our interests and our citizens. Netanyahu should know that we do not seek war, but we will stand firmly against any threat.

BLINKEN: Israel effectively thwarted the Iranian attack with help from the United States.

SULLIVAN: There will be major repercussions from this Iranian attack. We closely coordinated with the Israelis to intercept the Iranian attack. We will consult with the Israelis on the next step.

IRGC: Iranian Revolutionary Guard missiles targeted 3 Israeli military bases. The Revolutionary Guards use hypersonic Fatah missiles for the first time.

YEDIOTH AHRONOTH (Citing Israeli army): Tonight we will bombard areas in the Middle East with force.

Tuesday, October 1, 6:50 pm (GMT+2)

ISRAELI MEDIA: Preparations are underway for a "large-scale" Iranian attack targeting security facilities in Israel.

MSNBC: An Israeli military spokesman called on Iran via MSNBC to learn from what happened to Hezbollah and eliminate its leaders.

ISRAELI MEDIA: Sirens sounded in the greater Tel Aviv area of central Israel and West Bank settlements.

ISRAELI ARMY RADIO: Israeli Army Radio reported hearing an explosion in the greater Tel Aviv area. A rocket fell in an uninhabited area near Bat Yam, south of Tel Aviv.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: A Palestinian child was injured by Israeli occupation bullets in Balata camp in Nablus in the West Bank.

ANSRALLAH: The military spokesman for Ansarallah, Yahya Saree, said that they carried out 3 military operations targeting 3 ships in the Red Sea.

ISRAELI MEDIA: The shooting in the central area a short while ago was from Lebanon.

HOME FRONT COMMAND: The Israeli Home Front Command issues instructions to settlers in the Gush Dan area in Tel Aviv to stay near shelters.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Dead and injuries in a bombing that targeted a group of citizens at the entrance to Al-Bureij camp in the central Gaza Strip.

Tuesday, October 1, 6:00 pm (GMT+2)

AL-MAYADEEN: The US Embassy calls on its employees and Americans in the occupied Palestinian territories to go to shelters immediately and until further notice.

LEBANESE MEDIA: End of rubble removal at the site of the Ain al-Delb massacre in Sidon committed by the occupation on Sunday. The final toll is 71 martyrs and 58 wounded.

ISRAELI MEDIA: Violent explosions at Golani Junction in Lower Galilee

AL-MAYADEEN: An Israeli raid targeted the outskirts of the city of Nabatieh.

ISRAELI MEDIA: Four ballistic missiles were launched from Lebanon and fell off the coast of the city of Netanya, north of Tel Aviv.

LEBANESE MEDIA: There was significant material damage as a result of the two Israeli raids on the southern suburbs of Beirut.

HEZBOLLAH: We fired a salvo of Fadi 4 rockets at the Sde Dov air base on the outskirts of Tel Aviv.

AXIOS (citing senior Israeli official): Israel believes that the Iranian attack on it will be carried out in the next few hours.

NETANYAHU: We are at the height of the confrontation with the Iranian axis and we will be united.

Tuesday, October 1, 5:00 pm (GMT+2)

ISRAELI ARMY SPOKESMAN: Washington informed us of an airstrike near Iran. We will deal with any air threat from Iran as we have done before and we are highly prepared.

BLINKEN: Our country is closely following events in the Middle East, and is committed to defending Israel.

WHITE HOUSE: We have indications that Iran is preparing to launch a ballistic missile attack on Israel soon.

CHANNEL 13: A state of high alert in Israel following the expectation of an attack from Iran.

Tuesday, October 1, 3:30 pm (GMT+2)

RUSSIAN FM: The Russian Foreign Ministry "strongly condemned the Israeli attack on Lebanon and called on Israel to "immediately cease hostilities."

ISRAELI HOME FRONT COMMAND: Israel bans gatherings in open areas and buildings.

LEBANESE MEDIA: An Israeli raid targeted Al-Wad neighborhood, southeast of Baalbek city.

ISRAELI MEDIA: Sirens sounded in the north.

HEZBOLLAH: We targeted a gathering of enemy forces in the settlement of "Kfar Giladi" with a salvo of Katyusha rockets.

Tuesday, October 1, 3:00 pm (GMT+2)

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Six Palestinians were killed as a result of the occupation bombing of a civilian vehicle behind the Austrian Towers, west of Khan Yunis, in the southern Gaza Strip.

ISRAELI MEDIA: Ben Gurion Airport may be closed and consultations will be held in this regard in the coming hours

HOME FRONT COMMAND: The Home Front Command tightens its instructions to residents of the center and Jerusalem, urging them to stay near protected areas.

Tuesday, October 1, 2:00 pm (GMT+2)

HEZBOLLAH MEDIA RELATIONS: We call on all media institutions, professional, union and legal groups, international and Arab, to condemn this blatant Zionist aggression and expose the criminal practices committed by the enemy against the media and journalists

LEBANESE MEDIA: An Israeli raid targeted the outskirts of the town of Kokba in southern Lebanon.

WASHINGTON POST (citing Israeli official): A broader ground incursion into Lebanon is not on the table. There were no reports of clashes between army forces that entered Lebanon and Hezbollah militants.

CNN (citing Israeli official): No clashes have occurred on the ground between the Israeli army and Hezbollah so far.

CHANNEL 12: 15 shells were fired from Lebanon towards Metulla in the Upper Galilee, northern Israel.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Seven Palestinians, including a child and a woman, were killed when Israeli forces targeted a tent sheltering displaced people west of Khan Yunis city, south of the Gaza Strip.

AL-MAYADEEN: Six Palestinians were killed and a number of wounded as a result of an Israeli drone targeting a tent sheltering displaced persons west of Khan Yunis city in the southern Gaza Strip.

HEZBOLLAH: Our fighters targeted a gathering of enemy soldiers between the positions of Al-Ramtha and Al-Samaqa in the occupied Lebanese Kfar Shuba Hills with 32 Katyusha rockets.

ISRAELI MEDIA: Sirens sounded in Kfar Giladi and Misgav Am in the Galilee Finger.

EGYPTIAN SPEAKER OF HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES: What is happening in Lebanon is a blatant violation of a sovereign state, which portends the possibility of the outbreak of comprehensive regional confrontations.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Three Palestinians were injured by occupation forces' bullets west of Al-Nuseirat camp in the central Gaza Strip. HEZBOLLAH: There is no truth to the false claims of the Zionist enemy about the presence of weapons or weapons stores in civilian buildings, including the Al-Sirat Channel building, which was targeted by shelling in the southern suburb yesterday.

Tuesday, October 1, 1:15 pm pm (GMT+2)

HEZBOLLAH MEDIA RELATIONS OFFICIAL, MOHAMMED AFIF (to Al-Jazeera):

There has been no direct ground engagement yet between the resistance fighters and the occupation forces.

All Zionist claims that the occupation forces entered Lebanon are false.

The bombing of the 8200 Military Intelligence Base and the Mossad headquarters is just the beginning.

We will inflict the greatest losses on the enemy forces trying to enter Lebanese territory.

Our Mujahideen are ready to confront the enemy forces that dare or try to enter Lebanese territory.

AL-MANAR CORRESPONDENT:

Since yesterday, the occupation forces have continued their artillery and phosphorous shelling of the areas and towns adjacent to the border, in light of the intensive flight of enemy drones and warplanes to cover some movements close to Lebanese territory for fear of being targeted at any moment.

What the resistance has been doing since yesterday is confronting attempts to penetrate, but inside the occupied territories, by targeting the gatherings around the sites and settlements before they move.

Tuesday, October 1, 12:50 pm (GMT+2)

ISRAELI MEDIA: Sirens in Matula near the border with Lebanon continue almost without stopping.

GAZA CIVIL DEFENSE: Our crews recovered a body from a house targeted by the occupation's bombing in the Zaytoun neighborhood, and a woman is still missing under the rubble.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Injured in Israeli drone bombing that targeted a group of citizens in the Musbah area, north of Rafah city, south of the Gaza Strip.

ISRAELI MEDIA: The four soldiers who were injured during the clashes in Nablus are from the elite Duvdevan unit, and one of them is in critical condition

SECRETARY OF IRAN'S SUPREME NATIONAL SECURITY COUNCIL: Iranian support for Hezbollah will continue and that "the martyrdom of the party's leaders will not disrupt its power."

ISRAELI ARMY: The Israeli army called on residents of a number of villages in southern Lebanon to "evacuate their homes and leave their villages immediately."

UNIFIL: The Israeli army informed UNIFIL yesterday of its intention to carry out limited ground incursions into Lebanon. Any crossing into Lebanon constitutes a violation of Lebanese sovereignty and Resolution 1701.

Tuesday, October 1, 12:00 pm (GMT+2)

ISRAELI MEDIA: Ten ballistic missiles were launched from Lebanon towards Tel Aviv and northern Israel.

CHANNEL 12: Route 6 north of Tel Aviv was closed to traffic after a rocket fell on the road.

ISRAELI FIRE AUTHORITY: A fire broke out after a rocket fell near Kfar Saba, north of Tel Aviv.

REUTERS (Citing Israeli official): The ground operation in Lebanon will be limited, and that the option of a broader operation targeting Beirut is not on the table.

HEZBOLLAH: We bombed a gathering of enemy soldiers near the Rosh Pina settlement.

ISRAELI MEDIA: Tel Aviv police ask residents to stay in shelters.

HEZBOLLAH: At your service, Nasrallah, we launched a salvo of Fadi-4 missiles at the Glilot base of the Military Intelligence Unit 8200 and the Mossad headquarters in the suburbs of Tel Aviv.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Occupation helicopters fire on Al-Fakhari area, southeast of Khan Yunis, south of the Gaza Strip.

Tuesday, October 1, 11:00 am (GMT+2)

CHANNEL 12: Number of injuries from rocket barrage from Lebanon on central Israel rises to 3.

ISRAELI MEDIA: Rockets fired at central Israel from Lebanon are the largest since the beginning of the war.

AL-MAYADEEN: Gunfire from occupation vehicles west of Al-Nuseirat camp in central Gaza Strip.

SYRIAN MEDIA: Israel's aggression resulted in the martyrdom of 3 civilians, the injury of 9 others, and significant damage to private property.

HEZBOLLAH: We targeted a gathering of enemy forces in the "Dovif" barracks with a Falaq-2 missile.

ISRAELI MEDIA: Explosions were heard in northern and northeastern Tel Aviv.

AL-MAYADEEN: A salvo of rockets was fired towards northern occupied Palestine.

AMBREY: The ship, which was involved in an incident 97 nautical miles off Hodeidah, Yemen, was damaged by an unmanned boat.

ANSARALLAH: We carried out two military operations with drones on Jaffa and Eilat (Umm al-Rashrash) and achieved their goals. We targeted military sites in Eilat with 4 Samad 4 drones. We bombed a military target of the Israeli enemy in Tel Aviv with a Jaffa drone.

ISRAELI MEDIA: Sirens sounded in Metulla, Safed, Rosh Pina and several settlements in the Upper Galilee.

LEBANESE CIVIL DEFENSE: Nine people were killed and three were injured in an Israeli raid on the town of Daoudiya.

ISRAELI ARMY: The Lebanese army denied withdrawing from several kilometers of southern border posts, and the army explained that the military units deployed in the south are repositioning themselves at some forward observation points.

ISRAELI ARMY: The Israeli army said heavy fighting was taking place in southern Lebanon, and called on residents not to travel by vehicle from the north to south of the Litani River.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: A young man was shot by the occupation forces in Balata camp, coinciding with military reinforcements heading towards the camp.

UKMTO: A vessel reported being attacked by a drone boat 64 nautical miles northwest of Hodeidah, Yemen.

BEN-GVIR: Israeli forces are currently fighting in difficult conditions in southern Lebanon. This is the right time to crush Hezbollah and return the residents of the north to their homes.

ISRAELI AMBASSADOR TO WASHINGTON: The US administration understood the nature of the operation in Lebanon and did not restrict us by time.
