The Deir Al-Balah municipality said in a statement that 250,000 people were forcibly displaced within 72 hours, while 25 shelters were put out of service.

The Al-Qassam Brigades announced that its fighters carried out a tight ambush targeting an Israeli force of 5 soldiers in the Al-Qarara area east of Khan Yunis, killing and wounding them.

Several Palestinians were killed and wounded in an Israeli bombardment that targeted a school housing displaced people north of the Nuseirat camp in the central Gaza Strip.

According to Gaza's Ministry of Health, 40,435 Palestinians have been killed, and 93,534 wounded in Israel's ongoing genocide in Gaza starting on October 7.

**Tuesday, August 27, 12:00 am (GMT+2)** 

ISRAELI ARMY: We attacked the operations room in Nour Shams with a plane.

AL-JAZEERA: The occupation forces assassinated 5 people in a bombing with two missiles on a house in the Nour Shams camp, east of Tulkarm, in the West Bank.

Monday, August 26, 11:00 pm (GMT+2)

NETANYAHU (during a meeting with families of captive soldiers): We will not back down from our demand regarding the Philadelphi axis, and I do not care about the position of the security services.

UNICEF: Patients flee Al-Aqsa Hospital as hostilities loom.

## Monday, August 26, 9:00 pm (GMT+2)

HEZBOLLAH: We attacked the newly established headquarters of the 146th Division.

WHITE HOUSE: We have to assume that Iran is still prepared to attack Israel. Hezbollah's latest attack was large and different in scope from what we see every day.

KIRBY: Negotiations are currently focused on details, including the exchange of hostages and prisoners.

ICC PROSECUTOR: The delay in issuing arrest warrants for Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu and his Defense Minister Yoav Galant despite her request in May was a "deterioration of justice."

KAN (citing security, military sources): Israel can show more flexibility regarding the Philadelphi corridor

#### Monday, August 26, 8:00 pm (GMT+2)

PENTAGON SPOKESMAN: We did not participate in the strikes launched by Israel against Hezbollah positions on Sunday.

CHANNEL 12: An explosion hit Tel Aviv, according to eyewitnesses, and an investigation is underway.

AL-JAZEERA: A drone and missile attack took place on northern Israel, coinciding with the visit of the Israeli Chief of Staff and his American counterpart.

CHANNEL 12: Air defense systems fired interceptor missiles near the city of Nahariya in northern Israel.

HERZI HALEVI: Our mission in the north is to return residents to their homes.

YEDIOTH AHRONOTH: CIA Director William Burns asked the negotiators to be discreet and reduce statements regarding the ceasefire talks in Gaza.

# Monday, August 26, 7:00 pm (GMT+2)

SENIOR UN OFFICIAL: What happened in Gaza in the past few days has made us unable to conduct our operations, and this is beyond our control.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Israeli forces opened fire in the Al-Iqlimiya area south of Khan Yunis killing a Palestinian and injuring others.

AL-JAZEERA: Air raid sirens sounded in Yiftah, Hermon, Ayelet Hashahar and the Upper Galilee, fearing a drone infiltration from Lebanon.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Palestinian journalist Ali Taima was killed in an Israeli airstrike on the Al Mawasi area, west of Khan Yunis.

## **Monday, August 26, 6:00 pm (GMT+2)**

HAARETZ: Israel is on its way to a constitutional crisis due to the government's repeated disavowal of the decisions of the Supreme Court and the Attorney General.

FORMER ISRAELI MILITARY OFFICIAL: The achievements of the war are eroding due to the complete lack of clarity of objectives.

#### Monday, August 26, 5:00 pm (GMT+2)

QATAR: The Qatari Foreign Ministry said that Prime Minister and Minister of Foreign Affairs Sheikh Mohammed bin Abdulrahman Al Thani discussed with Iranian Foreign Minister Abbas Araghchi the situation in the Gaza Strip and developments in mediation efforts.

HRW: Polio outbreak in Gaza due to Israel's obstruction of aid.

#### Monday, August 26, 4:00 pm (GMT+2)

UN OFFICIAL AJITH SUNGHAI: I can't find words to express the magnitude of the tragedy in Gaza.

HEZBOLLAH: We bombed "the espionage equipment at the Ramya site with a suicide drone".

WFP: Food supply operations in Gaza face increasing challenges as the war continues.

# Monday, August 26, 3:00 pm (GMT+2)

HAMAS: The target of the Sidon bombing was a leader of the movement. He survived the raid.

MILITARY WATCH MAGAZINE: A group of mercenaries affiliated with an American military company called Forward Control Group moved part of its forces to Israel in late 2023.

BEN-GVIR: Benjamin Netanyahu was aware of his visits and decisions "on the Temple Mount" at Al-Aqsa Mosque.

GAZA HEALTH MINISTRY: 40,435 Palestinians have been killed, and 93,534 wounded in Israel's ongoing genocide in Gaza starting on October 7.

BEN-GVIR: Ben-Gvir attacked Israeli Defense Minister Yoav Galant, accusing him of bowing to Hamas and wanting to reach a prisoner deal that is not good for Israel.

ISRAEL: The Israeli occupation army said that it received more than 50 thousand tons of weapons, missiles and military equipment from the United States of America since October 7, via 500 flights and 107 sea shipments.

#### **Monday, August 26, 2:00 pm (GMT+2)**

LIEBERMAN: The response to Hezbollah should have been completely different.

GAZA CIVIL DEFENSE: Five Palestinians were killed and several others were injured in an Israeli attack on a group of Palestinians in Gaza City.

### Monday, August 26, 1:00 pm (GMT+2)

LEBANESE SECURITY SOURCES: The target of an Israeli airstrike on a car in Sidon survived and sustained minor injuries.

AL-JAZEERA: A car was targeted in the city of Sidon, southern Lebanon.

IRANIAN FM: The terrorist Israeli army has lost its deterrence and offensive power and must defend against strategic strikes.

GALLANT: Ben-Gvir's actions endanger Israel's national security and international standing.

#### Monday, August 26, 11:30 am (GMT+2)

AL-QASSAM BRIGADES: Our fighters carried out a tight ambush targeting an Israeli force of 5 soldiers in the Al-Qarara area east of Khan Yunis, killing and wounding them.

DEIR AL-BALAH MUNICIPALITY: 250,000 people were forcibly displaced within 72 hours, while 25 shelters were put out of service.

GAZA MUNICIPALITIES: Hospitals in the northern Gaza Strip are out of service and the occupation has destroyed agricultural crops and industrial facilities.

DEIR AL-BALAH MUNICIPALITY: The Al-Aqsa Martyrs Hospital has stopped operating after an Israeli order to evacuate the area that includes the hospital.

GANTZ: Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu is allowing National Security Minister Itamar Ben-Gvir to take the country to the abyss in exchange for political peace.

NETANYAHU'S OFFICE: There is no change to the legal status quo at Al-Aqsa Mosque.

#### Monday, August 26, 10:00 am (GMT+2)

YEDIOTH AHRONOTH: The Israeli army expanded the Netzarim axis by establishing 4 large military sites.

ISRAELI INTERIOR MINISTRY: Netanyahu must act immediately to put an end to Ben-Gvir's role in Al-Aqsa.

WAFA: Settlers stormed Al-Aqsa Mosque in Jerusalem, under the protection of the Israeli police.

HRW: The Israeli government continues to mistreat Palestinian medical personnel in Gaza and must stop this immediately.

#### Monday, August 26, 09:00 am (GMT+2)

YAIR GOLAN: Israel must have a real strategy to end the war or it will go on forever. Let's not fool ourselves, Hezbollah will not be eliminated and will not disappear from the map.

#### Monday, August 26, 08:00 am (GMT+2)

EU NAVAL MISSION IN RED SEA: The Greek-flagged ship "Sunion" has been under fire since August 23 after an attack by the Yemeni Houthi group, noting that there are no clear indications of an oil leak from the ship.

AL-JAZEERA: Air raid sirens are sounding in the southern occupied Syrian Golan Heights due to suspected infiltration of a drone.

#### Monday, August 26, 04:00 am (GMT+2)

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Israeli artillery shelled early Monday morning north of the Nuseirat camp in the central Gaza Strip.

#### Monday, August 26, 02:00 am (GMT+2)

SULLIVAN: I hope the situation with Hezbollah does not get out of control.

AL-JAZEERA: Several Palestinians were killed and wounded as a result of an Israeli airstrike on a house in the town of Abasan al-Kabira, east of Khan Yunis in the Gaza Strip.

#### Monday, August 26, 01:00 am (GMT+2)

EGYPTIAN SECURITY SOURCES: The talks held on Gaza in Cairo ended without reaching an agreement.

#### Monday, August 26, 12:00 am (GMT+2)

IRANIAN FM: Our response to the Israeli attack in Tehran will be decisive and well-calculated.
