The Israeli occupation forces bombed 25 targets in the Gaza Strip in the last 24 hours, killing scores of Palestinian civilians, including children.

Israeli media reported that Chief of Staff Herzi Halevi's resignation could be imminent and that discussion is taking place regarding his successor.

The Palestinian Resistance Movement Hamas confirmed it received an official response from the Israeli occupation to its proposal, which was presented to Egyptian and Qatari mediators on April 13.

According to Gaza's Ministry of Health, 34,388 Palestinians have been killed, and 77,437 wounded in Israel's ongoing genocide in Gaza starting on October 7.

Sunday, April 28, 02:00 am (GMT+2)

REUTERS: US State Department officials told Secretary of State Antony Blinken in an internal memo that they had found credible evidence that Israel is not using US weapons in accordance with international humanitarian law.

HEZBOLLAH: We shelled the settlement of Meron and surrounding settlements in the Upper Galilee with dozens of Katyusha rockets in response to enemy attacks.

MAARIV:

Netanyahu is scared and nervous about the possibility of an ICC arrest warrant.

Netanyahu has made intensive private contacts with Washington to prevent an ICC arrest warrant.

The issuance of the arrest warrant is believed to be only a matter of time and could include with Netanyahu the defense minister and chief of staff.

Sunday, April 28, 12:30 am (GMT+2)

AL-JAZEERA: 30 rockets were fired from southern Lebanon towards the Upper Galilee.

YEDIOTH AHRONOTH: About 10,000 people demonstrated in front of the Ministry of Defense.

AL-JAZEERA: Israeli police arrested two demonstrators who participated in the Tel Aviv demonstrations to demand a prisoner exchange deal with the resistance in the Gaza Strip.

YEDIOTH AHRONOTH (citing Israeli source): the opposition of Defense Minister Itamar Ben Gvir and Finance Minister Bezalel Smotrich is pushing Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu to abort an attempt to reach a prisoner exchange deal with Hamas.

### Saturday, April 27, 10:00 pm (GMT+2)

KAN: Ministers Bezalel Smotrich and Itamar Ben Gvir are threatening to withdraw from the government if Rafah is not invaded.

CHANNEL 14: Tel Aviv proposed that Hamas release 33 prisoners held by the resistance in exchange for the release of hundreds of Palestinian security prisoners.

WALLA: Israel offers new concessions regarding the exchange deal, including an "implicit willingness" to discuss ending the war, the full return of the displaced to their homes, and the army's withdrawal from the Netzarim Corridor.

### Saturday, April 27, 9:40 pm (GMT+2)

ARIZONA STATE UNIVERSITY: Arizona State University announced that 69 people were arrested for trespassing after setting up tents without a permit. Students at American universities stand in solidarity with the Palestinian cause, demanding an end to the war on Gaza.

ISRAELI MEDIA: Thousands of people marched towards the home of Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu in Caesarea to demand that he conclude an exchange deal.
