Norway's sovereign wealth fund may divest from Israel after adopting a new interpretation of ethics policy, according to Reuters news agency.

Israeli artillery shelling targeted the vicinity of the regional area northwest of Rafah city in the southern Gaza Strip.

The Israeli army decided to extend the period of its military operation in the Jenin camp, the Israeli newspaper Walla reported.

According to Gaza's Ministry of Health, 40,861 Palestinians have been killed, and 94,398 wounded in Israel's ongoing genocide in Gaza starting on October 7.

Thursday, September 5, 06:45 am (GMT+2)

- Al-JAZEERA: Sirens sounded in Yiftach in the Upper Galilee in northern Israel warning of rocket fire.
- PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Israeli occupation forces stormed the city of Nablus and Al-Ain camp in the northern West Bank.
- NBC (Citing informed sources): The Biden administration is considering a request by the families of American detainees in Gaza to conclude a deal with Hamas that does not include Israel.
- ISRAELI ARMY: The Israeli military said its air force carried out three drone strikes targeting a group of 'militants' in Tubas.
- PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Four Palestinians killed in Israeli shelling targeting the tents of displaced people in Shuhada Al-Aqsa Hospital in Deir al-Balah in the central Gaza Strip.
- PRC (The Palestinian Red Crescent): Five Palestinians were killed in an Israeli shelling of a vehicle in Tubas, in the northern West Bank.

Thursday, September 5, 12:00 am (GMT+2)

- SENIOR US OFFICIAL: The negotiations are complex and revolve around humanitarian aspects and a ceasefire in Gaza. There will be no ceasefire in Gaza without a settlement on the prisoner exchange.
- EGYPTIAN MEDIA: Netanyahu's statements are a preemptive message to Washington that he rejects proposals for a ceasefire.
- WASHINGTON POST: Netanyahu's conflicting messages cause confusion in Gaza ceasefire talks.
- ALGERIA'S REPRESENTATIVE TO UNSC: Israel continues to impose collective punishment on the Palestinians.
- ISRAELI OFFICIALS: Egypt succeeded in eliminating tunnels and arms smuggling from its side.

Wednesday, September 4, 11:00 pm (GMT+2)

- IRANIAN GENERAL CHIEF OF STAFF: We will respond harshly to Haniyeh's assassination.
- UN OFFICIAL: Gaza's medical system has been destroyed.
- US STATE DEPARTMENT: Israel accepted the American proposal and we are working to bridge the gap, and this requires greater flexibility from Israel and Hamas.
- CHANNEL 13: The American plan will include withdrawal from the Philadelphi corridor.
- AXIOS (citing German official): The German government is frustrated by Netanyahu's policy on the prisoner exchange deal and his failure to prioritize it.

Wednesday, September 4, 9:00 pm (GMT+2)

- KAN POLL: 53% of Israelis support withdrawal from the Philadelphi corridor to reach a deal.
- AXIOS: US and Israeli officials discussed ways to prevent a war between Israel and Hezbollah. The US-Israeli virtual meeting on Lebanon lasted for an hour.
- ISRAELI ARMY: 30 rockets were fired from southern Lebanon towards northern Israel in the latest batch.
- NETANYAHU: On October 7, we witnessed the greatest and most horrific barbarism against Jews since the Holocaust. Our control of the Philadelphi corridor is essential to achieving the war's goals.
- AL-QASSAM BRIGADES: In a video recorded before his death, Israeli captive Alexander Lobanov said that Qassam fighters transferred him 10 times to save his life.

Wednesday, September 4, 7:00 pm (GMT+2)

- GAZA CIVIL DEFENSE: Two Palestinians were killed and 11 others were injured in an Israeli airstrike on a house in the Zeitoun neighborhood, southeast of Gaza City.
- AL-JAZEERA: Gunfire targeted Israeli occupation forces near the Cinema Roundabout in the center of Jenin, in the northern West Bank.
- PALESTINIAN MEDIA: One person was killed in an Israeli drone attack on citizens at the Al-Hawja junction in the Jabaliya refugee camp, in the northern Gaza Strip.

Wednesday, September 4, 6:30 pm (GMT+2)

- GERMAN FM: There is no military solution to Gaza or the situation in the West Bank. There is a risk of escalation of violence in the West Bank, and fighting terrorism does not involve tearing up streets and destroying water lines.
- LEBANESE HEALTH MINISTRY: A woman was killed and two other people were injured in an Israeli bombardment on the town of Qabrikha in the south of the country.
- AL-QUDS BRIGADES: We are engaged in fierce clashes in Nur Shams camp.

Wednesday, September 4, 5:30 pm (GMT+2)

- HEZBOLLAH: We fired rockets at the Al-Marj border post with Israel and achieved a direct hit.
- GALLANT: We must use all necessary means and with all force in the West Bank.
- EGYPTIAN PRESIDENT EL-SISI: We demand an immediate ceasefire in Gaza.
- ERDOGAN: Netanyahu's government policies are putting the region and the whole world in danger.

Wednesday, September 4, 4:30 pm (GMT+2)

- GAZA CIVIL DEFENSE: Five people, including three women and a child, were killed in an Israeli bombing of a house in the Sheikh Radwan neighborhood north of Gaza City.
- LAPID: It's time to change the government and end the war.
- AL-QASSAM BRIGADES: We will publish a video recording of the two slain prisoners, Alexander Lubnov and Carmel Gat, at 7:00 pm this evening.
- AL-JAZEERA: Israeli occupation forces expanded the scope of their operations in Tulkarm, in the northern West Bank, and continue to bulldoze its streets.
- CHANNEL 12: Five shells were fired from Lebanon towards Zar'it in the Western Galilee, northern Israel, some of which fell in the area without causing any injuries.
- AL-JAZEERA: Three people, including a woman and a child, were killed in an Israeli bombardment of a house in the Nuseirat camp in the central Gaza Strip.

Wednesday, September 4, 4:00 pm (GMT+2)

- PALESTINIAN HEALTH MINISTRY: 33 citizens were killed and 140 others were injured by Israeli bullets since the start of the Israeli military operation in the occupied West Bank.
- AL-JAZEERA:Israeli occupation bulldozers razed areas inside the city of Tulkarm. Israeli occupation forces are still stationed at the eastern entrance to Jenin camp and are deploying snipers in several buildings.
- HEZBOLLAH: We shelled a position of Israeli occupation soldiers in the Zar'it barracks with artillery, achieving a direct hit.

Wednesday, September 4, 3:00 pm (GMT+2)

- HAARETZ (citing a source in government coalition): Netanyahu decided a few weeks ago that he did not want to reach an agreement.
- ISLAMIC JIHAD: The occupation's expansion of its aggression in the West Bank will not achieve its goals.
- AL-QASSAM BRIGADES: Our fighters and other factions are engaged in clashes with the occupation in the Tulkarm camp in the West Bank, and have killed and wounded soldiers.
- HAMAS: The Security Council's meeting to discuss the file of the Zionist prisoners while the genocide against our people continues raises signs of disapproval and astonishment.
- PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Several Palestinians were killed and wounded in an Israeli raid on a residential house in the middle of the Nuseirat camp in the Gaza Strip.

Wednesday, September 4, 2:00 pm (GMT+2)

TIMES OF ISRAEL: Israel has assured Qatar that its army will withdraw completely from Philadelphia in the second phase of the ceasefire.

- PALESTINIAN MEDIA: The Israeli occupation artillery renewed its shelling of the Al-Zeitoun neighborhood, southeast of Gaza City.
- GAZA HEALTH MINISTRY: 40,861 Palestinians have been killed, and 94,398 wounded in Israel's ongoing genocide in Gaza starting on October 7.
- HAARETZ (citing US official): We want the exchange agreement more than Netanyahu and Sinwar.
- ISRAELI ARMY RADIO: 60 rockets were fired from Lebanon since Wednesday morning.
- HEZBOLLAH: We bombarded the Sahel Battalion Command in the Beit Hillel barracks and the Israeli enemy's artillery positions in Dishon with Katyusha rockets.

Wednesday, September 4, 1:00 pm (GMT+2)

- AL-JAZEERA: An Israeli raid targeted the vicinity of the town of Kounine in southern Lebanon.
- ISRAELI ARDIO: Fires broke out in Kiryat Shmona and its surroundings as a result of shells fired from Lebanon.
- PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Six Palestinians were killed in an Israeli bombardment that targeted a gathering of Palestinians in the vicinity of Sheikh Zayed Towers in the northern Gaza Strip.
- AL-JAZEERA: Rockets were fired from southern Lebanon towards Israeli sites in the Upper Galilee and the Galilee Finger.

Wednesday, September 4, 12:00 pm (GMT+2)

- PALESTINIAN MEDIA: A Palestinian was killed in an Israeli bombardment that targeted a house in the Nuseirat camp in the central Gaza Strip.
- CHANNEL 12: Several shells from Lebanon fell in the Kiryat Shmona area.
- ISRAELI ARMY RADIO: The army arrested a suspect in the village of Idhna in Hebron who helped the perpetrator of the Tarqumiya operation.
- CHANNEL 12: The Israeli army is asking the settlers of Kiryat Shmona in the Galilee Finger to stay near the shelters.
- PRCS: Two foreign activists were injured when settlers attacked them during their raid on the village of Qusra, south of the city of Nablus in the West Bank.
- LAPID: As long as this government exists, the war will continue.

Wednesday, September 4, 11:00 am (GMT+2)

- HAARETZ: Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu's decision against the deal was made weeks ago, explaining that he "discovered that the Philadelphi corridor is an effective trick."
- WSJ: Most of the terms of the deal have been agreed upon, and Hamas is the least willing to agree.
- HAMAS: The occupation is adopting a policy of deliberate killing against Palestinian prisoners.

- IRANIAN QUDS FORCE: Our response to the assassination of Ismail Haniyeh will be different and we will not reveal its method.
- KAN: The mediators had contacted Israeli officials to inquire about the possibility of flexibility in the negotiations.
- ISRAELI RADIO: The head of the Mossad was the one who informed the mediators that Israel would withdraw from the Philadelphi corridor in the second phase of the deal.

Wednesday, September 4, 10:00 am (GMT+2)

- AL-JAZEERA: Intensive flights of Israeli warplanes in the skies of the city and camp of Jenin in the West Bank.
- ISRAELI ARMY RADIO: The political leadership proposed opening a criminal investigation to avoid the International Criminal Court issuing arrest warrants, noting that the government's attorney general is demanding the formation of an official investigation committee to examine the International Criminal Court's allegations.
- AL-AQSA IMAM: The incursions are increasing and this is a provocation to the feelings of Muslims.
- YEDIOTH AHRONOTH: Explosive devices in West Bank camps cause losses to the army.
- AL-JAZEERA: The Israeli army is sending more reinforcements to Jenin camp in the West Bank.
- BEN-GVIR: I am working to stop negotiations with Hamas.

Wednesday, September 4, o9:00 am (GMT+2)

- AL-JAZEERA: Sirens are sounding in Shamir in the Upper Galilee, fearing a drone infiltration.
- PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Israeli artillery shelling targeted the vicinity of the regional area northwest of Rafah city in the southern Gaza Strip.
- AL-JAZEERA: The Israeli occupation army is firing heavily inside neighborhoods in Jenin camp in the West Bank.
