Hamas, Prisoner's Authority Release Names of Prisoners to Be Freed Tomorrow

HAMAS:

Hamas and the Palestinian Prisoners' Authority released the list of prisoners who will be freed as part of the "Freedom of the Heroes" deal:

16 from Fatah 11 from Islamic Jihad 2 from the Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine (PFLP) 2 from the Democratic Front for the Liberation of Palestine (DFLP) 1 from Hamas

Among those to be freed:

Mohammad Abu Warda (sentenced to 48 life sentences).

Zakaria Zubeidi, a resistance fighter from the 2002 Jenin Camp invasion and one of the prisoners from the Gilboa Tunnel Escape in 2021.

Sami Suleiman Jarradat, sentenced to 23 life sentences.

Humanitarian Protocol in Gaza Revealed

AL-JAZEERA:

Sources told Al-Jazeera that the humanitarian protocol for Gaza affirms the commitment of relevant parties to work in accordance with international humanitarian law.

The protocol ensures regular meetings between the guarantors to monitor its implementation during the ceasefire and commits to fulfilling the requirements of the May 27, 2024 agreement.

It also ensures sufficient humanitarian aid, including 600 trucks per day, and the entry of 60,000 caravans and 200,000 tents to accommodate displaced people.

Furthermore, the protocol calls for the repair of infrastructure, including the power station, and enhanced coordination for early recovery efforts.
