Resistance Proposed Increasing Number of Prisoners in Swap

AL-JAZEERA: Palestinian sources:

The proposal to increase the number of Israeli prisoners to be released before Friday came as a decision by the Resistance in Gaza, not due to a negotiation crisis.

The number of living Israeli prisoners in the first phase is higher than expected, sufficient for more than 6 weeks of exchange.

The Resistance preferred not to limit the remaining number of prisoners for exchange in the final week, as per the agreement.

This initiative by the Resistance came to bring more relief to our people and to avoid limiting the exchange count to the final week as per the agreement.

The Resistance's initiative to increase the released prisoners coincided with the crisis of displaced persons' return, offering a solution to that problem.

Israeli media confirmed that the list aligns with what is known in Tel Aviv, with 18 hostages alive and 8 bodies.

Israeli Army: We will Allow Displaced People to Return on Monday Morning

STATEMENT: The spokesperson for the Israeli army has announced:

Displaced people will be allowed to return on foot to northern Gaza via the Netzarim route and Al-Rashid Street from 7:00 AM local time.

Vehicles will be allowed to pass after inspection to northern Gaza via the Salah al-Din Road starting from 7:00 AM local time.

Access to the Rafah crossing, the Philadelphia corridor, and areas where our forces are stationed in Gaza is prohibited.

We warn against swimming, fishing, diving, or entering the Gaza Sea in the coming days.

Starting Monday morning, Israel will permit displaced Gaza residents to return to northern Gaza. Hamas is also set to hand over three additional Israelis on Saturday. Furthermore, Israel will provide a list of 400 individuals detained since October 7.
