At least 33 Palestinians were wounded in the Israeli artillery shelling of the Beit Lahia project in the northern Gaza Strip.

Residents of the Hula Valley towns were advised to stay near protected areas for fear of renewed shelling and drone infiltration after the Israeli army monitored the launch of at least 30 rockets from Lebanon.

The Israeli army continued to storm several villages, towns and refugee camps in the occupied West Bank.

According to Gaza's Ministry of Health, 40,878 Palestinians have been killed, and 94,454 wounded in Israel's ongoing genocide in Gaza starting on October 7.

Sunday, September 8, 12:00 am (GMT+2)

WASHINGTON POST (citing US officials): US officials say they have indefinitely postponed presenting a final proposal to Hamas and Israel.

KAN: The commander of the US Central Command will arrive in Tel Aviv tomorrow to hold talks with senior officials.

Saturday, September 7, 11:00 pm (GMT+2)

KAN: Half a million people are demonstrating in Tel Aviv, and 250,000 in the rest of Israel.

LAPID: Netanyahu must stop politics and make a deal.

Saturday, September 7, 10:20 pm (GMT+2)

CNN (Citing a senior administration official): We know that the Ministry of Defense and the Israeli army want to end the war. The army needs a break and reequipment in anticipation of a war in the north.

ISRAEL MEDIA: Thousands of Israelis are taking part in a demonstration in front of Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu's residence in Jerusalem.

KAN (Israel Broadcasting Corporation):

The US administration has called the deal proposal being drafted a "last chance."

The proposal may be presented tomorrow or within the next few days.

The US administration has expressed hope for a deal, at least in the media.

The US settlement proposal includes all the points of contention, foremost of which is the Philadelphia axis.

MEDIA: The Association of Families of Israeli Prisoners said more than 400,000 people were taking part in the Tel Aviv demonstration.

Saturday, September 7, 8:00 pm (GMT+2)

UN RAPPORTEUR ON RIGHT OF FOOD: Israel began a starvation campaign in Gaza only two days after the start of its war on the Strip.

AL-JAZEERA: Air raid sirens are sounding non-stop in several locations in the Upper Galilee, fearing the infiltration of drones.

LEBANESE HEALTH MINISTRY: Three civil defense personnel were killed and 2 others were injured in an Israeli raid on the town of Frun, south of Lebanon.

AL-JAZEERA: Thousands of Israelis took part in a march in the city of Haifa, demanding a prisoner exchange deal.

Saturday, September 7, 7:00 pm (GMT+2)

HEZBOLLAH: We intercepted an Israeli Heron drone with a missile in the Bekaa Valley, forcing it to leave Lebanese airspace.

AL-JAZEERA: Israeli forces stormed the entrance to Al-Fawar camp, south of Hebron, and fired live bullets and tear gas bombs intensively.

Saturday, September 7, 6:00 pm (GMT+2)

AL-JAZEERA: Israeli forces stormed the entrance to Al-Fawar camp, south of Hebron, and fired live bullets and tear gas bombs intensively.

HEZBOLLAH: We shelled the Israeli Al-Marj position with artillery shells, achieving a direct hit.

Saturday, September 7, 5:00 pm (GMT+2)

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Four Palestinians, including two children, were killed and others were injured as a result of Israeli shelling of a house east of the Nuseirat camp.

AL-JAZEERA: There were casualties after the occupation bombed Amr Ibn Al-Aas School in Sheikh Radwan neighborhood, west of Gaza City.

HEZBOLLAH: We targeted and destroyed the espionage equipment at the Misgav Am site.

Saturday, September 7, 4:00 pm (GMT+2)

DIRECTOR OF BRITISH INTELLIGENCE: Hamas's military capabilities have been severely degraded, but not eliminated. Hamas is a movement and an idea, and you can only kill it with a better idea.

CIA DIRECTOR: We are seeking to reach a mutually acceptable exchange proposal, and look forward to submitting a proposal soon.

Saturday, September 7, 2:30 pm (GMT+2)

HEZBOLLAH: We targeted a deployment of Israeli occupation soldiers around the settlement of Manot with rockets.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: A Palestinian was killed as a result of gunfire from an Israeli drone on a group of citizens in Wadi Gaza, west of the Nuseirat camp.

Saturday, September 7, 2:00 pm (GMT+2)

ISRAELI ARMY RADIO: The Israeli Army Radio reported a direct hit on a house in the town of Shlomi in the Western Galilee as a result of a rocket fired from Lebanon.

AL-JAZEERA: Rockets were fired from southern Lebanon towards Israeli sites in the Upper Galilee.

JERUSALEM POST: Some of the rockets fired from Lebanon damaged a house in Shlomi and caused a fire in Liman, the Jerusalem Post reported.

LEBANESE MEDIA: Israel launched two raids, one on the outskirts of the town of Qabrikha and the other on the outskirts of the town of Bani Hayyan in southern Lebanon.

Saturday, September 7, 1:00 pm (GMT+2)

AL-JAZEERA: A Palestinian was killed by Israeli occupation forces' fire near the Kerem Shalom crossing, southeast of Rafah city.

GAZA HEALTH MINISTRY: 40,939 Palestinians have been killed, and 94,616 wounded in Israel's ongoing genocide in Gaza starting on October 7.

Saturday, September 7, 12:00 pm (GMT+2)

ISRAELI HOME FRONT: Residents of the Hula Valley towns should stay near protected areas for fear of renewed shelling and drone infiltration.

LAPID: We must make a deal and end the war.

CNN: Obstacles to negotiations over Gaza have raised White House doubts about the end of the war before the end of Biden's presidency. It is not clear what effect the arms embargo on Israel would have on the behavior of a government that includes Ben-Gvir and Smotrich.

HEZBOLLAH: We targeted the Hadab Yaroun site with artillery shells.

ISRAELI HOME FRONT: Sirens were sounding in Eyelet Hashahar in Upper Galilee due to the suspected infiltration of a drone.

NABLUS GOVERNOR (to Al-Jazeera): The autopsy of the American-Turkish activist confirmed that she was killed by an Israeli sniper.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: The bodies of two martyrs were recovered after an Israeli bombardment on the Araba area, north of Rafah city.

Saturday, September 7, 10:00 am (GMT+2)

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Five people were killed and others were injured in an Israeli raid on the Al-Hasayna area, west of the Al-Nuseirat camp in the central Gaza Strip.

AL-JAZEERA: Injured in an Israeli raid on a group of Palestinians west of the Nuseirat camp in the central Gaza Strip.

FORMER HEAD OF SIN BET: Israel is not qualified for long wars and this war should have ended a long time ago.

Saturday, September 7, 09:00 am (GMT+2)

MEDICAL SOURCES: The number of people injured in the Israeli artillery shelling of the Beit Lahia project in the northern Gaza Strip has risen to 33 Palestinians.

Saturday, September 7, 08:00 am (GMT+2)

ISRAELI ARMY: We monitored the launch of about 30 rockets.

HEZBOLLAH: We bombed the Mount Neria base with Katyusha rockets in response to Israeli attacks on southern Lebanon.

AL-JAZEERA: Air raid sirens are sounding in the Ras al-Naqoura and Western Galilee areas after a suspected drone infiltration from Lebanon.

PALESTINIAN SOURCES: Intermittent artillery shelling targeted the vicinity of the electricity company north of the Nuseirat camp in the central Gaza Strip.

Saturday, September 7, 07:00 am (GMT+2)

AL-JAZEERA: Sirens are currently sounding "in the vicinity of Mount Meron and Matat in the Western Galilee, northern Israel."

Saturday, September 7, 06:00 am (GMT+2)

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: The Israeli occupation artillery is renewing its shelling of the Al-Zaytoun neighborhood, southeast of Gaza City.

Saturday, September 7, 04:00 am (GMT+2)

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Several people were killed and wounded as a result of the Israeli bombardment of a residential apartment in Al-Bureij camp in the central Gaza Strip.

Saturday, September 7, 03:00 am (GMT+2)

AL-JAZEERA: The occupation forces stormed the town of Beitunia, west of Ramallah, and Baqa al-Hatab, east of Qalqilya, in the West Bank."

Saturday, September 7, 02:00 am (GMT+2)

AL-JAZEERA: The Israeli occupation forces stormed the town of Samou, south of Hebron, and raided citizens' homes.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA. Several Palestinians, including children, were killed as a result of an Israeli bombardment of a house in the Al-Nasr area, west of Gaza City.
