An Israeli officer and three soldiers from the Givati Brigade were killed and others wounded on Monday during fierce battles in the city of Rafah, in the southern Gaza Strip.

The Israeli army said it monitored the launching of about 50 missiles from Lebanese territory towards the central Golan while sirens sounded in Haifa.

Israel continued to bomb various areas throughout the Gaza Strip, including Rafah and Jabaliya.

According to Gaza's Ministry of Health, 37,164 Palestinians have been killed, and 84,832 wounded in Israel's ongoing genocide in Gaza starting on October 7.
