14 people were killed and 43 wounded as a result of an Israeli airstrike in the Masyaf area in Syria, the Syrian news agency reported.

The Indonesian Hospital and the Kamal Adwan Hospital in Gaza may go out of service in the next 48 hours due to Israel's ban on the entry of fuel and medical supplies.

Israeli Finance Minister Bezalel Smotrich said that the government is doing its best to return the detainees but that the country cannot commit "collective suicide" for that.

According to Gaza's Ministry of Health, 40,988 Palestinians have been killed, and 94,825 wounded in Israel's ongoing genocide in Gaza starting on October 7.

Tuesday, September 10, 02:45 am (GMT+2)

REUTERS (Citing local sources): The number of those killed in the Israeli strike on the tents of displaced people in Khan Yunis has risen to at least 40.

GAZA'S HEALTH MINISTRY: Scores were killed in the Israeli raid on tents belonging to displaced refugees in Khan Yunis in the southern Gaza Strip.

Tuesday, September 10, 02:30 am (GMT+2)

GAZA CIVIL DEFENSE: 65 displaced people were recovered between dead and wounded in the Mawasi Khan Yunis massacre. Recovery operations were continuing.

GAZA CIVIL DEFENSE:

The Israeli airstrikes targeted a gathering of IDPs tents consisting of at least 20 inhabited tents in an area declared by the occupation as 'safe zones.'

The heavy strikes left three large craters.

A number of martyrs were buried in the ground, and ambulance crews and civil defense are facing great difficulty in retrieving martyrs amid the lack of capabilities and the lack of a light source.

Residents in the surrounding area panicked as they were sleeping when the strikes began.

The event is very difficult, and it is estimated that we are facing one of the most horrific massacres.

Rescue operations are ongoing.

The occupation has become emboldened to carry out such massacres in light of the complete silence of the institutions of the world regarding previous crimes.

GAZA CIVIL DEFENSE: Israeli shelling that targeted the tents of displaced people in the Mawasi area of Khan Yunis in the southern Gaza Strip left a 9-meter-deep crater.

Tuesday, September 10, 12:15 am (GMT+2)

KAN (Israel Broadcasting Corporation): Army foiled a drug smuggling attempt on the Egyptian border and there was a shooting and an attempt to run over soldiers.

SOCIAL MEDIA: Thousands of Jordanians flocked to the funeral home set up by the family of Maher Al-Jazi, a Jordanian who killed three Israeli soldiers at the Karameh (Allenby) Crossing operation.

CAZA CIVIL DEFENSE: Five Palestinians, including two women and a child, were killed in Israeli shelling that targeted residential apartment west of Gaza City.

UNITED NATIONS/MEDIA REPORTS: The Israeli military stops a UN convoy in northern Gaza. The army claimed that the convey was not transporting polio vaccines and said intelligence indicated that a number of "Palestinian suspects" were in the convoy. (The Director-General of the Ministry of Health in Gaza confirmed that the convoy was transporting medicines for polio vaccines.)

Monday, September 9, 10:00 pm (GMT+2)

AL-JAZEERA: A Palestinian youth was injured by Israeli occupation bullets in Al-Arroub camp, north of Hebron in the West Bank.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Israeli occupation aircraft targeted a house west of Gaza City.

KIRBY: We are trying to reach a ceasefire agreement in Gaza. Hamas is the main obstacle to reaching a ceasefire in Gaza.

FAMILIES OF ISRAELI PRISONERS: Netanyahu did not miss any opportunity to obstruct the deal to return the captives from Gaza.

Monday, September 9, 9:00 pm (GMT+2)

CHANNEL 13: The United States is reconsidering its mediation proposal. Washington realizes that the current climate does not allow for the proposal to be presented and does not want it to fail.

US STATE DEPARTMENT: We have no further information on the circumstances of the American activist's death and have asked Israel to investigate.

Monday, September 9, 8:00 pm (GMT+2)

ERDOGAN: We will take legal steps to hold Israel accountable for killing Turkish activist.

GAZA CIVIL DEFENSE: 5 people were killed in an Israeli bombardment that targeted a residential apartment in the Tal al-Hawa neighborhood, southwest of Gaza City.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Three Palestinians were killed in Israeli bombing near Rafah land crossing in the southern Gaza Strip.

AXIOS: Biden will meet with his national security team today to discuss the impasse in ceasefire negotiations.

HEZBOLLAH: We targeted a deployment of Israeli occupation soldiers around the Matla site with rockets.

Monday, September 9, 7:00 pm (GMT+2)

GULF MINISTERIAL COUNCIL: We demand an immediate ceasefire in Gaza.

ISRAELI MEDIA: Two anti-tank missiles were fired towards the town of Metula in the eastern sector of the border with Lebanon.

Monday, September 9, 6:00 pm (GMT+2)

ISRAELI MEDIA: Two rockets were fired towards Metulla.

AXIOS: Israeli pressure on Congress to force South Africa to drop its case at the International Court of Justice

AL-JAZEERA: A missile was fired towards the Israeli site of Ruwaysat al-Alam in the occupied Kfar Shuba hills, while an Israeli airstrike targeted the town of Kfar Kila in southern Lebanon.

Monday, September 9, 5:00 pm (GMT+2)

HEZBOLLAH: We bombed the occupation's spying equipment at the Ramtha site in the occupied Lebanese Kfar Shuba hills.

LAVROV: We are working with the parties to resolve the Palestinian crisis because the escalation has moved to a conflict on the Lebanese border and in the Red Sea.

Monday, September 9, 4:00 pm (GMT+2)

MEDICAL SOURCES: At least 14 Palestinians were killed as a result of the Israeli bombing of the Gaza Strip since dawn today.

AL-JAZEERA: Two rockets were fired from southern Lebanon towards the Israeli Ramtha site in the occupied Kfar Shuba hills.

HAMAS: The occupation's aggression against Palestinian education is a Zionist crime that will not succeed in obliterating the identity of our people and obscuring their national rights.

AL-JAZEERA: Sirens are sounding in Kiryat Shmona and its surroundings, fearing that rockets will be launched from Lebanon.

AL-AQSA MARTYRS HOSPITAL SPOKESMAN (to Al-Jazeera): The occupation continues to pressure to put the remaining hospitals out of service.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: the number of victims of the Israeli bombing that targeted a house in the north of the Nuseirat camp in the central Gaza Strip has risen to two.

Monday, September 9, 3:00 pm (GMT+2)

HEZBOLLAH: We forced an Israeli warplane to leave Lebanese airspace.

EGYPTIAN FM: Claims that weapons entered Gaza from our side are pure lies.

AL-JAZEERA: Armed clashes are taking place between resistance fighters and Palestinian security forces in Jenin camp.

HEZBOLLAH: We attacked the headquarters of the Golani Brigade and the Egoz Unit 621 in the Shraga barracks north of Acre with suicide drones.

BRAZILIAN FM: The situation in the Gaza Strip is unbearable and requires action to protect civilians.

ISRAELI MEDIA: About 15 rockets were fired from Lebanon at the Galilee.

MIKATI: Israel's targeting of civilians is a violation of international law and a threat to the safety of the Lebanese people.

HAMAS: If Netanyahu is not pressured and forced to abide by what was agreed upon, the occupation prisoners will not see the light.

GERMANY: The German Foreign Ministry spokesman said that the situation in Gaza is catastrophic.

Monday, September 9, 2:00 pm (GMT+2)

AL-JAZEERA: Sirens sounded in areas of the Western Galilee after rockets were fired from Lebanon.

MAARIV: The budget deficit continues to rise and reached 8.3% of the gross domestic product last August.

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: One person was killed and others were injured in an Israeli bombardment that targeted a house in the Sabra area, south of Gaza City.

CHANNEL 12: 12 Palestinians were arrested on Route 6 on suspicion of planning an attack.

Monday, September 9, 1:00 pm (GMT+2)

AL-HUWAITAT CLAN: The blood of our martyred son is not more precious than the blood of our Palestinian people, and he will not be the last of the martyrs. Full responsibility for what happened at the King Hussein Bridge lies with Benjamin Netanyahu, the first and last person responsible.

ISRAELI ARMY RADIO: The commander of the US Central Command met yesterday with senior army officials at the Northern Command headquarters in Safed.

SYRIAN FM: The occupation's persistence in its attacks on Syria and other countries indicates its quest for further escalation in the region. We warn against the continued international silence regarding Israel's disregard for international laws and demand condemnation of the aggression.

Monday, September 9, 12:00 pm (GMT+2)

MAARIV: Senior General Staff officials are working to prevent the October 7 investigation from ending.

MEDICAL SOURCES: Ten Palestinians were killed in Israeli raids on various areas in the Gaza Strip since dawn today.

AVIGDOR LIEBERMAN: Nahariya should be treated like the Tel Aviv bloc and chaos in the north should not be tolerated.

Monday, September 9, 11:00 am (GMT+2)

IRANIAN FM: Damascus announced that the attack at dawn today targeted research centers linked to the Ministry of Defense and the Syrian army.

DIRECTOR OF KAMAL ADWAN HOSPITAL: The occupation wants to put us out of service and does not allow fuel alternatives to enter hospitals.

SMOTRICH: The current war is the result of 30 years in which Israel chose not to act effectively against terrorism in Gaza. No progress toward destroying Hamas because the military refuses to take responsibility for humanitarian aid to Gaza.

AL-JAZEERA: Israeli forces stormed Al-Fawar camp, south of Hebron, the town of Bil'in, west of Ramallah, and the towns of Silwan and Issawiya in occpied Jerusalem.

Monday, September 9, 10:00 am (GMT+2)

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Four Palestinians were killed in an Israeli bombardment that targeted a house in the Al-Bureij camp in the central Gaza Strip.

AL-JAZEERA: A Palestinian was killed and a number of citizens were injured in an Israeli bombardment that targeted a house in the Al-Daawa area, north of the Al-Nuseirat camp.

LEBANESE HEALTH MINISTRY: Four people were injured in an Israeli raid on the town of Hanin, south of Lebanon.

Monday, September 9, 09:00 am (GMT+2)

SMOTRICH: We will end the war when we crush Hamas and Hezbollah. There is no agreement to return the detainees and we are doing our best to bring them back alive but we will not commit mass suicide for that.

AL-JAZEERA: The Jordanian Bridges Security Administration announced the closure of King Hussein Bridge to passenger and cargo traffic for today and until further notice.

AL-JAZEERA: Sirens sound in several areas of the Hula Valley, the Galilee and the Upper Galilee after shelling was detected from Lebanon.

DIRECTOR OF INDONESIAN HOSPITAL: The hospital may stop working within 48 hours, due to the ban on the entry of fuel and medical supplies.

GANTZ: If we do not reach an agreement, we will be forced to enter a war in the north.

AL-JAZEERA: Israeli artillery shelling targeted Beit Hanoun, north of the Gaza Strip.

Monday, September 9, 08:00 am (GMT+2)

ISRAELI MEDIA: The Israeli air force launched 5 raids last night and this morning on sites inside Syria.

AL-JAZEERA: Air raid sirens sounded in the Manara area in the Upper Galilee on the border with Lebanon.

Monday, September 9, 07:00 am (GMT+2)

KAN: The Israeli Air Force bombed a weapons development research center in Syria.

Monday, September 9, 06:00 am (GMT+2)

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Four Palestinians were killed in an Israeli occupation bombing that targeted a house in Al-Bureij camp in the central Gaza Strip.

AL-JAZEERA: Air raid sirens sounded in the settlement of Netiv Ha'asara in the Gaza Strip envelope.

Monday, September 9, 02:30 am (GMT+2)

PALESTINIAN MEDIA: Armed clashes erupted between resistance fighters and Israeli occupation forces in the Tulkarm refugee camp.
