Since October 7, 2023, Israel has killed 50,277 Palestinians and injured 114,095 others, the majority of whom are women and children, according to the Palestinian Ministry of Health in Gaza.

Gallant: Investigate All Political and Military Officials Regarding the Period Before October 7

“The plan was prepared in June 2023 by former Chief of Staff Halevi, the Shin Bet, and the Southern Command.

“The Government Coordination Unit proposed accepting Hamas’s rule and recommended implementing the idea of a long-term ceasefire.

Channel 12 also reported that a government document revealed that the Government Coordination Unit had presented a settlement plan with Hamas months before October 7.

300 Gaza Children, Women Killed in One ‘Horrific Night’ – Haaretz

According to the report, citing official data from the Palestinian Health Ministry, the devastating Israeli airstrike on Gaza in the early hours of March 18 killed at least 436 Palestinians, including 183 children, 94 women, and 34 elderly people.
