Hamas Responds to NYT Claims Attributed to Top Official

The Palestinian Resistance Movement Hamas issued a statement asserting the following:

Hamas denied the accuracy of statements attributed to Dr. Mousa Abu Marzouk in an interview published by The New York Times on Monday. They clarified that the interview, conducted several days ago, had its content taken out of context, misrepresenting the full scope of Abu Marzouk's answers.

Dr. Abu Marzouk emphasized that the October 7th operation was a legitimate act of resistance, reflecting the Palestinian people's right to oppose the siege, occupation, and settlement activities.

He reiterated that the Israeli occupation is responsible for committing war crimes and genocide against the people of Gaza, violating international law and shocking the global community.

Hamas reasserted its firm stance in favor of the Palestinian people's right to resist in all forms, particularly through armed struggle, until the full liberation of Palestine is achieved.

Dr. Abu Marzouk stressed that the weapons of resistance belong to the Palestinian people, with the aim of protecting them and their holy sites. He underscored that these weapons cannot be relinquished or negotiated away as long as Palestine remains under occupation.
